1. Website structure

The EDIAQI project website is structured into five main sections:

- Home
- About
- Pilots
- Articles
- Contact

The general look and feel of the website have been designed to make it look attractive and welcoming, whilst being accessible for all users. The project team has also paid attention to presenting the project in a way that can be understood by all audiences, as we know that the website will be the starting point for everyone who wishes to find out more about the EDIAQI project. The project website has been developed in Drupal, an open-source platform for building digital experiences.

1.1 Home

The home page is where most visitors to the EDIAQI project website will begin their journey to find out more about the project. The website begins by providing visitors with a short introduction to EDIAQI, what it stands for and shows a button which leads them to a brief outline of the project on a separate page. The home page also highlights the challenges regarding indoor air quality and how the actions in the EDIAQI project will overcome these challenges.

There is a specific section on the home page to provide the key statistics related to the project, such as the number of project partners, the funding received from the European Commission and the number of pilots and measurement campaigns that will be carried out. Additional information is then provided on each of the four pilot sites and four measurement campaigns.



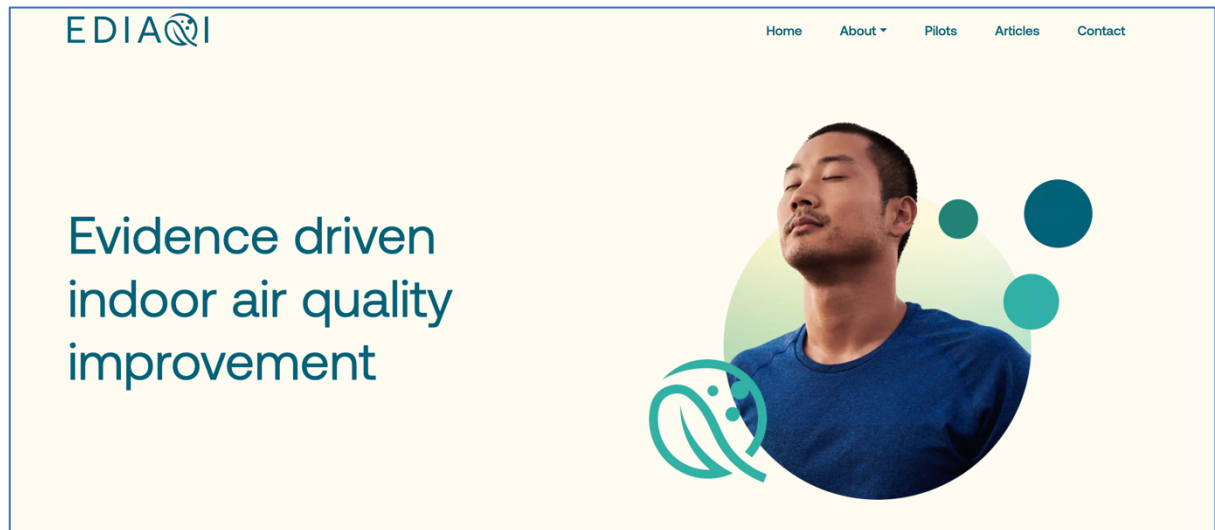


Figure 1 Home page on the EDIAQI website

The Home page also features the latest news items and articles published by the EDIAQI consortium and provides visitors with the chance to sign up the project newsletter that is expected to be published approximately twice a year.

Finally, the home page shows all the partners involved in the project and provides basic information such as the funding instrument and a contact email for anyone wanting to find out more information.

1.2 About

The About section, contains three subsections including a description of the project, an overview of the partners involved in the project and information about the governance structure of the project.

1.2.1 Description of the project

The first section gives visitors an overview of the mission and the vision of the EDIAQI project, including the key objectives of the projects and an insight into the main results that are expected after the project has finished.

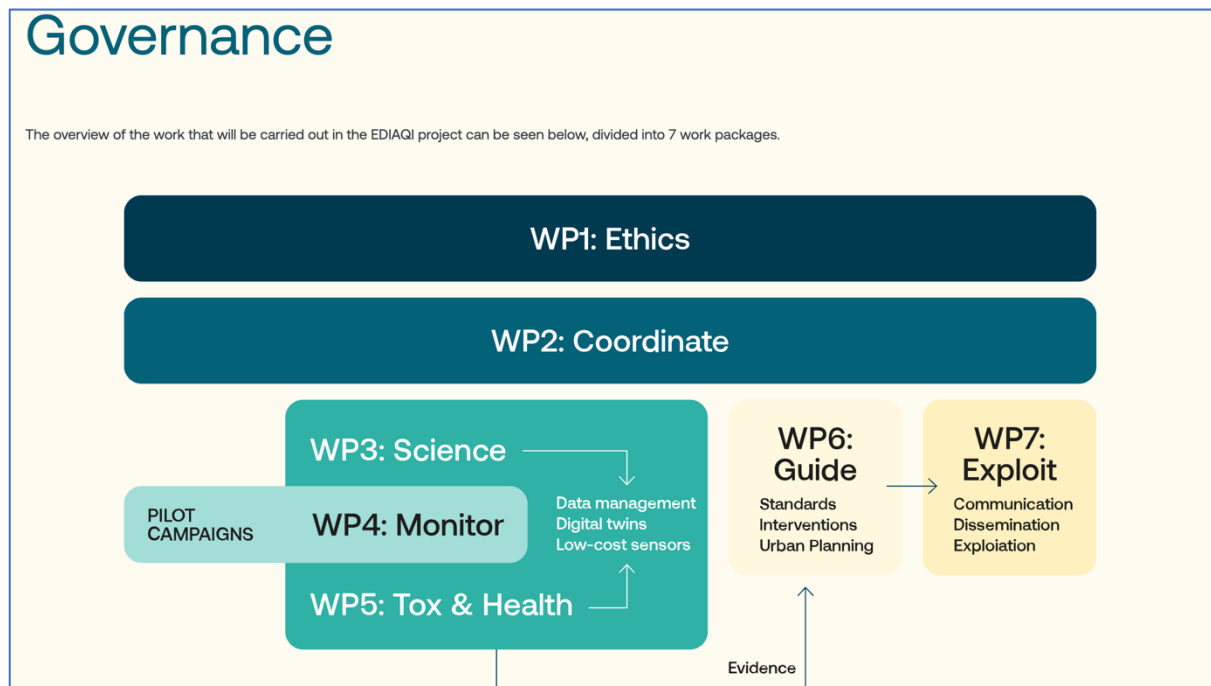


Figure 4 Governance section on the EDIAQI website

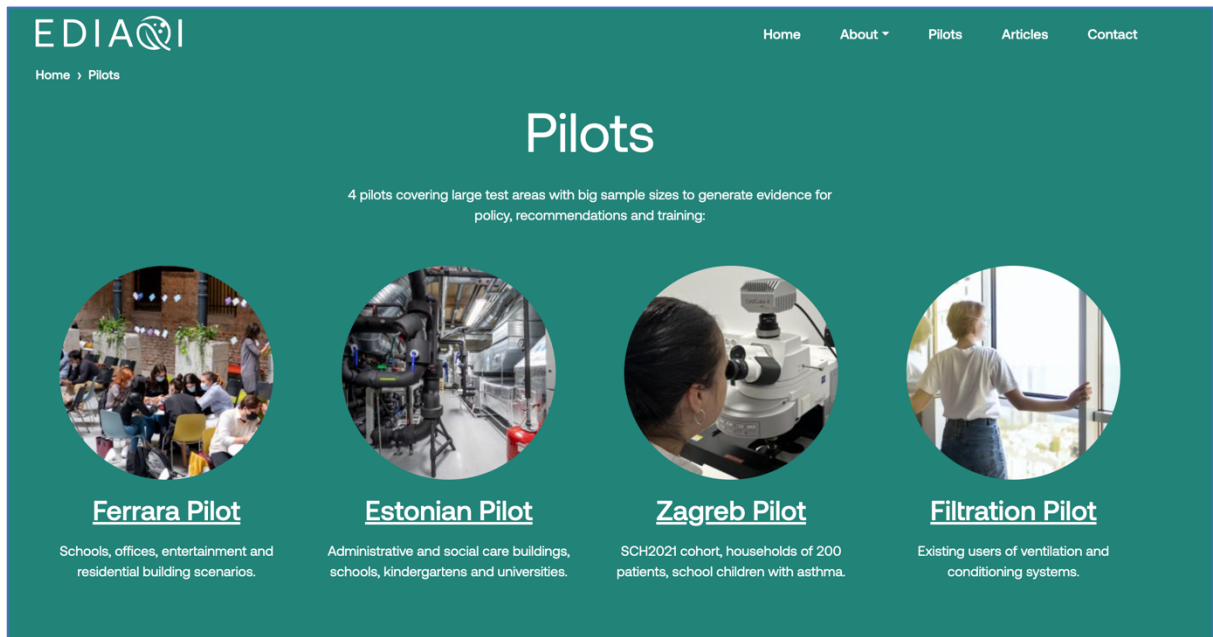


Figure 5 Pilot's section on the EDIAQI website

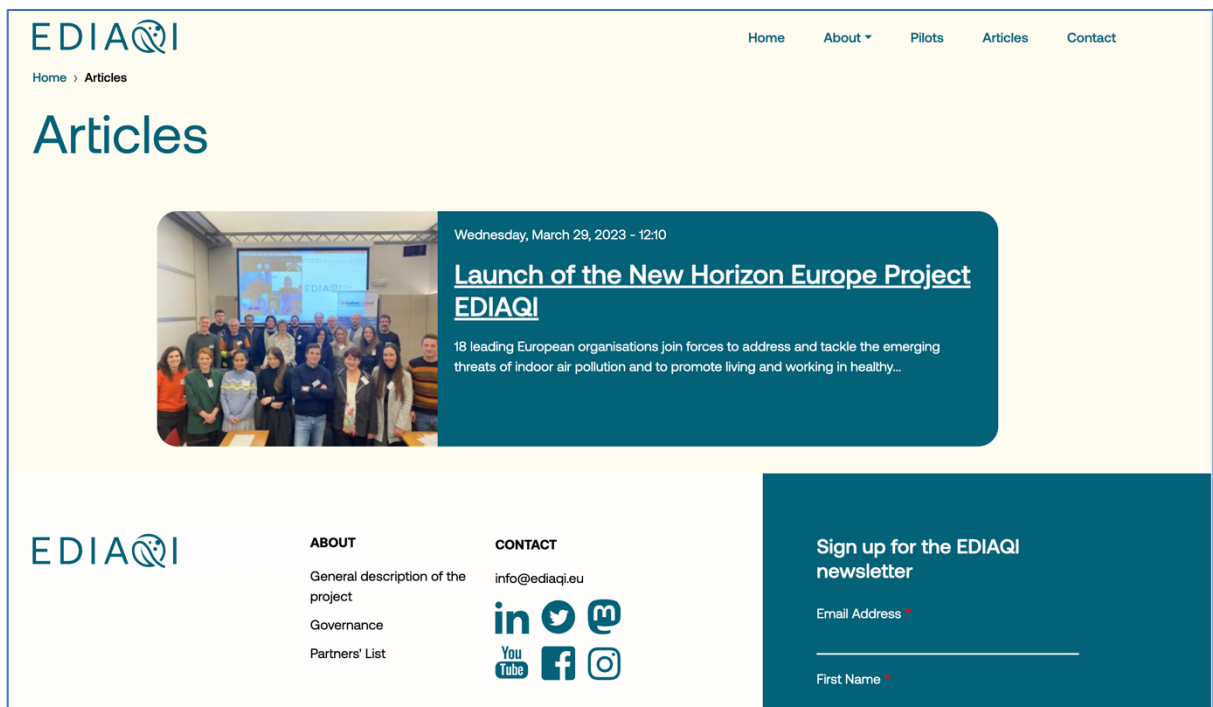



Figure 6 Articles section on the EDIAQI website
